● ARGENTINA, SPAIN FACEOFF IN FIFA FINAL

Night before final, all fan lines lead to Messi

Whatever climax, Argentinian to be the protagonist

IN THE BASEMENT of Javits Hall, supporters of Argentina and Spain fidgeted in the sinuous queue to the Fanatics Festival in the heart of New York, two days before the final in MetLife Stadium. The gruff security guard quizzically verified the loyalties of every new entrant, "Spain in the line over there and Argentina down here. No fights, no punches please. I know you guys are sweet."

Both groups of fans were separated by barricades nearly 50 m ahead but he had read about the skirmishes between England and Argentina fans in Times Square on Thursday. The two lines, as if in a procession outside a temple, are unified in their singular wish. To spot the deity, Lionel Messi, who would be on stage for five fleeting minutes. Each entry to the hall came at \$82, and not all of the 10,000-odd crowd would be granted access to the hall. Some were wrapped in flags of their country, most in shirts of their

favoured players. There were other celebrities, Rodri and Emi Martinez, Novak Djokovic, Kevin Durant and Tom Brady, in the whistle-stop show. But all that mattered was Messi. Those in the Argentina line wore the blue and white stripes; some in the Spain queue wore Messi's jerseys, too. The same No 10, but in the red and purple of Barcelona. "We will cheer for both Messi and Spain," blared Nehemias Collar. "It's a cruel choice, I know. Maybe I want to see Messi win, because this would be his last World Cup. Lamine (Yamal) is still young and has time to win more in his life," he added. Argentina fan Miguel Galego from Santa Fe, was in Qatar when Messi lifted the World Cup. He showed the

selfie. "But I want to witness the moment once more," he said.

The all-pervading protagonist of the final is Messi, whether he will bow out with a second title on the spin, one that would, for his devout, end all debates of whether he is the greatest of all time, bigger than Diego Maradona and Pele. Or whether the slickly oiled Spanish technicians would end his career in the grand stage. It's a heavy burden on Yamal's lithe shoulders, but he has a happy knack of wearing burdens lightly. "I don't try to be another Messi or Cristiano (Ronaldo)," he had said.

Some fans waved printouts of the viral photograph of Messi

bathing Yamal when he was four months old. Later in the evening, the American football legend Brady asked Messi about the story behind the photo-shoot. Messi sheepishly replied, in Spanish: "It's insane. That picture with Lamine, now we are facing in a final after a photo was taken of when he was a baby."

Both sides have individuals other than Messi, who leads the golden boot with eight strikes and four assists, and Yamal, to define games. But heroes have sprung for Argentina in clutch moments. Enzo Fernandez's curler ignited the stirring fight-back against England that they cinematically wrapped up with the Lautaro Martinez header. Pedro Porro, Lisandro Martinez and Julian Alvarez have all seized their moments when their team's fortunes hinged on the balance. Argentina wouldn't mind Spain wouldn't possess them, but would look to storm them in short, explosive bursts. De La Fuente snubbed a reporter when asked if Spain were the overwhelming favourites. "There are two super teams. There are many similarities in behaviour and talent in footballers. No one is a favourite, not in a final," he said. But whatever the script or climax, the protagonist would be Messi.

Record ticket prices fail to deter fans

SUNDAY'S FINAL CAPS a World Cup where fans were willing to shell out more than ever for a seat at the quadrennial showpiece, as ticket buyers confounded even the greatest cynics in the face of sky-high prices. The match is widely billed as the single most expensive sporting event ever played in the US.

It is a fitting end to a tournament that has tested the limits of what fans will spend. "What FIFA did a very good

job of was determining what demand would be because people (were) paying these absurd prices for just about all the 104 matches," said Scott

Friedman, a ticketing expert.

A Reuters analysis of FIFA attendance data found that more than half the 72 group matches were attended to capacity. Hundreds of tickets were still available for the final on Wednesday, priced at little more than \$7,000 on FIFA's platform. By Friday, nearly all tickets appeared to be sold, with a few listed on FIFA's sales platform at around \$32,000 a ticket.

FIFA introduced dynamic pricing for the first time at this tournament, allowing ticket prices to fluctuate based on

real-time demand.

Lax rules around the resale market in the US have only served to accelerate the pocket-emptying around the tournament, with second-hand ticket sellers largely empowered to set their own prices. A final-week listings brought prices down on resale platform SeatGeek, with the average ticket for the final listed for over \$11,000. Still, that figure easily made the final the most expensive event that the platform had sold, 8% above the 2024 Super Bowl, SeatGeek said.

Top federal prosecutor backs Adani case drop

THE TOP FEDERAL prosecutor in Brooklyn said he had no basis to dispute the US Department of Justice's decision to abandon its prosecution of billionaire Gautam Adani, but stopped short of saying whether he agreed with dismissing the fraud and bribery case.

In a letter on Friday to the judge overseeing the case, US Attorney Joseph Nocella Jr. said he was "not the decision-maker" behind dropping the case, and had no basis to believe the reasons advanced by his supervisor Trent McCotter, a top Justice Department official, were not the "real grounds" for a dismissal.

US District Judge Nicholas Garaufis had asked Nocella to explain whether he agreed or disagreed with McCotter's reasons for dropping the Adani case, and whether there were other bases for doing so.

McCotter, whose title is principal associate deputy attorney general, in a July 4 letter cited several reasons to dismiss Adani's case.

Wangchuk taken to hospital, Dipke begins hunger strike

CJP continues to protest, demands PM Modi's resignation

CITING MEDICAL ADVICE and Delhi High Court directions, police whisked away activist Sonam Wangchuk to Safdarjung Hospital on Saturday morning on the 21st day of his hunger strike at the Jantar Mantar.

Ignoring police's call to leave the protest site, the Cockroach Janta Party (CJP) escalated its agitation over the NEET paper leak issue with its founder Abhijeet Dipke announcing an indefinite hunger strike soon after the "crackdown".

Shortly after his hospitalisation, Wangchuk's wife, Gitanjali J Angmo, in two letters to the Medical Superintendent of Safdarjung Hospital, directed that no oral or intravenous medicine or fluid be administered to Wangchuk without her consent and sought copies of all medical reports. She also requested that he be

discharged so he could be shifted to a medical facility of the family's choice.

Hospital authorities issued a bulletin at 3:30 pm, saying Wangchuk, 59, has refused intravenous fluids, oral rehydration solution and other medications despite signs of dehydration and metabolic abnormalities. Following the police action, the youth-led outfit escalated its agitation, demanding Prime Minister Narendra Modi's resignation and vowing to press ahead with its planned Parliament march on July 20.

The CJP later said on X that Wangchuk has "not broken" his

hunger strike and he will continue it from hospital.

Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi said the action against a person on a non-violent hunger strike was wrong and accused the government of relying on "Asatya and Hinsa" (falsehood and violence).

The BJP maintained that authorities acted with empathy, balancing the court's directions with the imperative of protecting life and questioned the "outrage". The ruling party also hit out at opposition, asking whether they would have preferred his health to deteriorate merely to sustain a "political spectacle".

72nd National Awards: Article 370 best feature film

Veteran Malayalam actor



Mammootty and Bollywood star Kartik Aaryan shared the best actor award for *Bramayugam* and *Chandu Champion* respectively.

Inspired by the government's decision to abrogate the special status accorded to the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir, *Article 370* features Gautam as an intelligence offi-

cer involved in a covert operation linked to the developments leading up to the abrogation. The movie is directed by Aditya Suhas Jambhale.

Actor-filmmaker Randeep Hooda won the best debut director award for *Swatantrya Veer Savarkar*, his first directorial venture in which he also plays Vinayak Damodar Savarkar.
